CITY OF NORTON RESOLUTION NO. __-2018

A RESOLUTION CONFIRMING THE APPOINTMENT OF JUSTIN MARKEY TO A TWO-YEAR TERM AS A REPRESENTATIVE ON THE LOCAL BOARD OF TAX REVIEW OF THE CITY OF NORTON AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, Mayor Zita has appointed Justin Markey to a two-year term as a representative on the City of Norton Local Board of Tax Review, which term commences on April 1, 2018 and expires March 31, 2020; and

WHEREAS, such appointment must be confirmed by Council.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of Norton, Counties of Summit and Wayne, and State of Ohio:

- Section 1. The appointment of Justin Markey as a representative to the City of Norton Local Board of Tax Review for a two-year term commencing April 1, 2018 and expiring March 31, 2020, is hereby confirmed.
- All formal actions of this Council related to this Resolution and all deliberations of the Council and of any of its Committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
- Section 3. CITY OF NORTON ORDINANCE NO. __-2018

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR AND/OR CITY ADMINISTRATOR TO EXECUTE AND DELIVER A CONTRACT FOR LEGAL SERVICES IN CONNECTION WITH LEGAL ACTION RELATED TO PROPERTY DAMAGE ON HOUSTON ROAD, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the City has incurred thousands of dollars in property damage to Houston Road in connection with the improper and negligent operation of a cement mixer and tow truck; and,

WHEREAS, the City has determined it to be in the community's best interest to file a legal action against those various entities and individuals causing and in connection with the property damage to Houston Road in order to pursue any actionable claims against the entities or individuals; and,

WHEREAS, the City has determined to participate in the legal action against Orrville Trucking and other necessary, related entities and individuals, and to engage the law firm of DiCaudo, Pitchford & Yoder as legal counsel for the City in connection with such legal action.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of the City of Norton, Counties of Summit and Wayne, State of Ohio:

- Section 1: This Council hereby authorizes the Mayor and/or City Administrator to engage DiCaudo, Pitchford & Yoder to act as legal counsel for the City in connection with its legal action against Orrville Trucking and various other entities and individuals for the property damage to Houston Road on or about October 9, 2017.
- Section 2: That the aforesaid recitals are rendered to be the findings of this Council and are hereby incorporated into this Ordinance.
- Section 3: It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
