Robert Fowler called the meeting to order at 6:32 pm.

## **CONSIDERATION OF MINUTES:**

Mayor Mike Zita presented the Monday, March 26, 2018, Board of Control meeting minutes as written for approval. Mr. Pelot moved to accept the minutes, seconded by Mr. Kernan.

ROLL CALL:

YEA VOTES: Messrs, Pelot, Kernan, Fowler, and Messner

NAY VOTES: None ABSTENTION: None

Motion passed unanimously.

#### **NEW BUSINESS:**

1) Enter into an agreement with Huntington Public Capital Corporation for the Lease-Purchase of a Ford F-550XL Truck in an amount not to exceed \$65,000.

Mr. Fowler introduced the lease-purchase of a 1 ton dump truck for the City of Norton Service Department. The truck and chassis will be purchased from Ganley Ford while the stainless steel bed will be from ARM Equipment. The financing will be provided by Huntington Public Capital Corporation.

A motion was made by Mr. Fowler, seconded by Mr. Pelot to accept the proposal by the Service Department for the purchase of a 1 Ton Dump Truck.

2) Contract for Houston Road repair with a quoted amount of \$9,040 plus 10% contingency for a total amount not to exceed \$12,500.

Mr. Fowler discussed the contract that would enter an agreement with Sable Services, Inc. DBA Sable Asphalt Maintenance to repair the Houston Road damage properly from a cement truck that overturned in October. The base installation will be 2.5" with a surface installation of 2.0".

A motion was made by Mr. Kernan, seconded by Mr. Pelot to accept the agreement with Sable Services, Inc. DBA Sable Asphalt Maintenance for the repair of Houston Road.

#### Motion passed unanimously.

3) Enter into agreement with Environmental Design Group for contract of New Park Drive in an amount not to exceed \$45,223.

Mr. Fowler introduced the engineering of New Park Drive prior to submission and asks that this contract be expedited in order to facilitate engineering completion prior to July 1. The length is approximately 1,750 feet and the goal is to replace the existing concrete pavement.

A motion was made by Mr. Pelot, seconded by Mr. Messner to accept the agreement with Environmental Design Group.
