**NORTON HEALTH ADVISORY BOARD
CITY OF NORTON
Wednesday, July 29, 2009**

The Health Advisory Board (NHAB) of the City of Norton, Ohio, convened for a public meeting in Council Chambers of the Safety Administration Building. Chairman Daniel Karant called the meeting to order at 7:00a.m. Ms. Delnay was excused.

II. CONSIDERATION OF MINUTES:

The Board reviewed the minutes of Wednesday, May 20, 2009. **Chairman Karant called for a motion. Ms. Spisak moved to approve the minutes as submitted; seconded by Mr. Safron. ROLL CALL: Ms. Spisak-Yes, Mr. Safron - Yes, Mr. Karant-Yes, and Brenda Hlas - Yes. The motion passed 4-0, approving the minutes as written.**


III. OLD BUSINESS:

IV. NEW BUSINESS:

Chairman Karant welcomed Bob Hasenyager from Summit County Health District (SCHD). Bob Hasenyager distributed the June 2009 report to the Board. (See Attached) Mr. Hasenyager stated that SCHD has received the records from Barberton except for the Construction & Demolition (C & D) landfill sites and any nuisance complaints filed before the change. Mr. Hasenyager stated that the Barberton Health Department (BHD) has been very responsive in the transition. He informed the Board that there had been over 60 inspections on septic systems in the zones. Mr. Hasenyager stated that SCHD and BHD visited both Eslich C & D landfill on Wadsworth Rd. and Summit McCoy C & D landfill on Summit Rd. Mr. Hasenyager stated that they have almost reached an agreement with the financial assurance for the Eslich C & D landfill. He stated that SCHD and the City of Norton Building Department is working together on the house at 3188 Houston Rd. They have talked to the people who own the property and are trying to help them find permanent residence since the house can not be inhabited. Mr. Hasenyager stated they are receiving stimulus money to help people replace old septic systems that are bad. The Board questioned Mr. Hasenyager with concerns about mosquito spraying and he stated that they do mosquito surveillance by using different kinds of traps. They check the traps and send for testing and they prefer to spray for larva in the water that lies in the ditches. Mr. Hasenyager stated that a good proposal would be for SCHD to do the service of the mosquitoes and the money that MAD collects could go for cleaning ditches and enclosing the ditches. Chairman Karant asked Mr. Hasenyager about the septic situation at 3535 Easton Rd. that he called about and stated that they had to change to celebrations because of the odor that was emanating from the address. Mr. Hasenyager stated that SCHD had not yet been to the address and it was going to be one of the addresses to check for the septic. Mr. Hasenyager stated that Debbie Fetzer is starting to set the Flu Clinics for the different areas in the county. Chairman Karant asked if there were any more questions for Mr. Hasenyager, and being none the Board thanked Mr. Hasenyager for coming.

V. ADJOURNMENT:

The next meeting will be held on August 19, 2009 at 7:00pm in Council Chambers. There being no further business coming before the Board, Chairman Karant adjourned the meeting at 8:00pm.
