Current Clinic Needs

- OTC medications & medical supplies (Tylenol, gloves, bandages)
- Equipment (crutches, walkers, EKG/lab supplies)
- Monetary donations for patient medications (e.g. insulin)
- Patient transportation assistance
- Provide 1 meal/month for clinic staff
- Custodial help 1 night/month
- Agency partnerships (housing, mental health, etc.)



How Churches Can Help

- Encourage medical professionals to volunteer
- Provide spiritual support volunteers
- Offer 1 monthly staff meal (for ~8 people)
- Offer 1 monthly cleaning support
- Share the Care Center with those in need
- Pray regularly for our mission
- Be a spiritual home for patients
- Nominate a liaison for our Church Council





Faithful Servants Mission, Inc. is a 501(c)(3) nonprofit providing free urgent care to the uninsured and working poor. Endorsed by major health systems in Summit and Medina Counties, we are supported by community foundations, hospitals, churches, businesses, and individuals.

Founded in 2012 in Tallmadge, Ohio, our mission is to deliver compassionate, Christ-centered care to those without access to standard healthcare. Licensed physicians and clinicians volunteer their time, and services are offered regardless of age, condition, or faith. Pastoral counseling is available upon request.

We operate without government funding and rely entirely on volunteers. We welcome churches, organizations, and individuals to partner with us in meeting the physical and spiritual needs of our communities.

Our Wadsworth clinic, located at 251 Leatherman Rd., currently offers evening care Tuesdays and Thursdays from 5:30–8:30 p.m., with plans to expand to 5–7 days a week as volunteer capacity grows.
